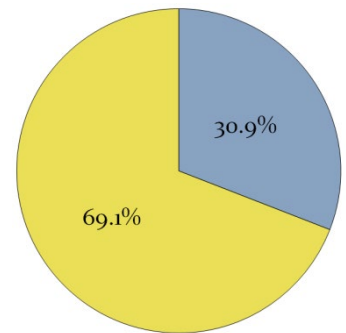

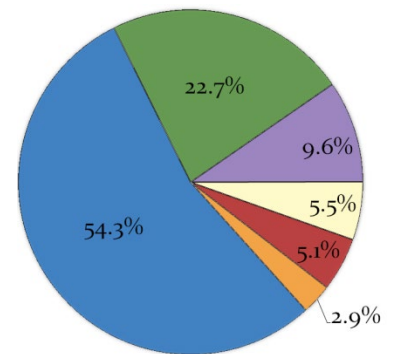

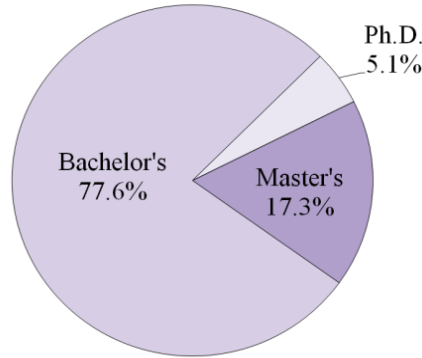

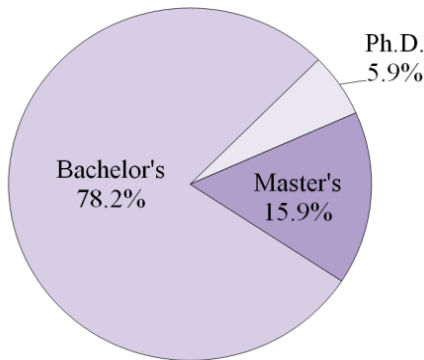


# New Mexico Tech by the Numbers

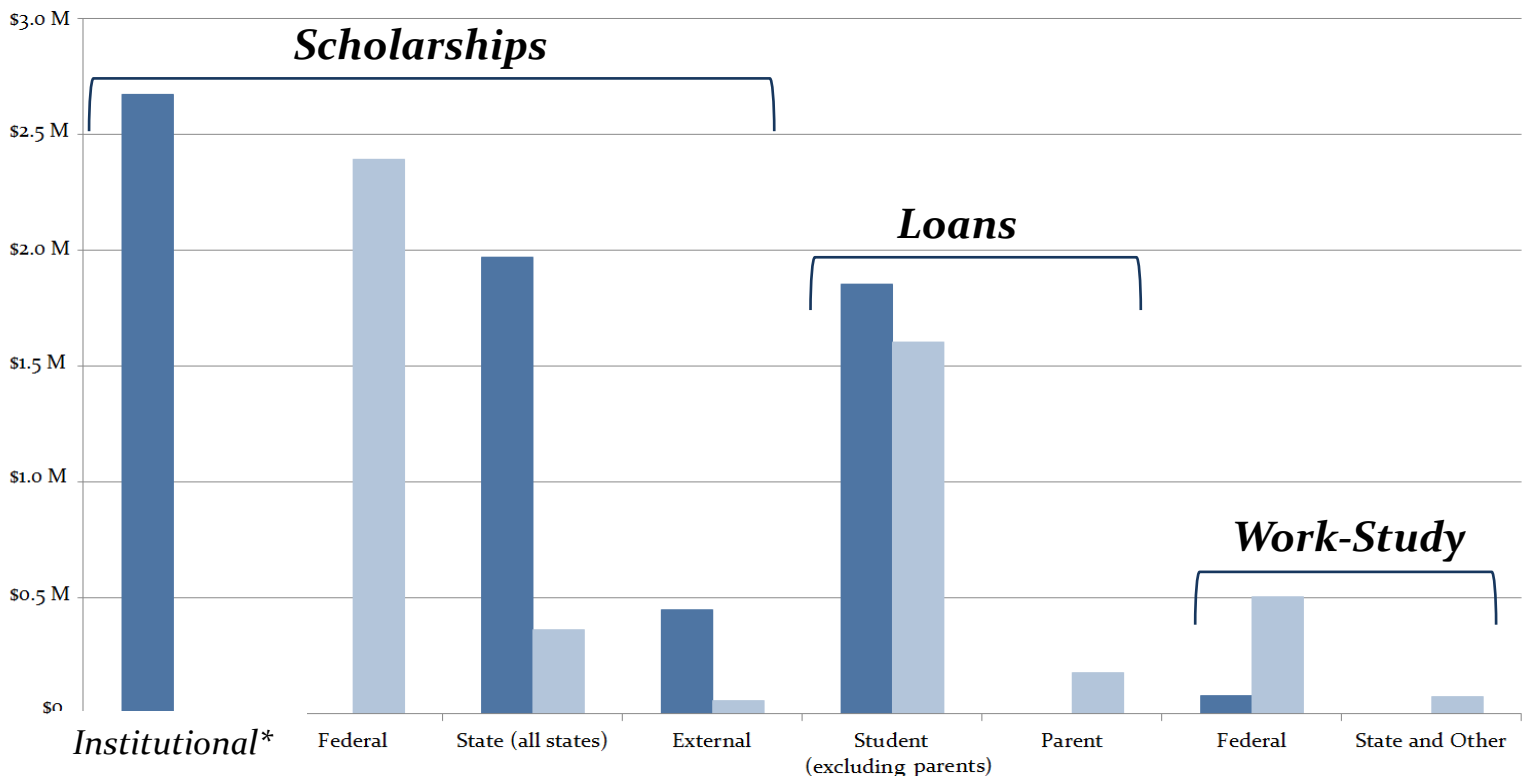

## Undergraduate Financial Aid 2017-2018

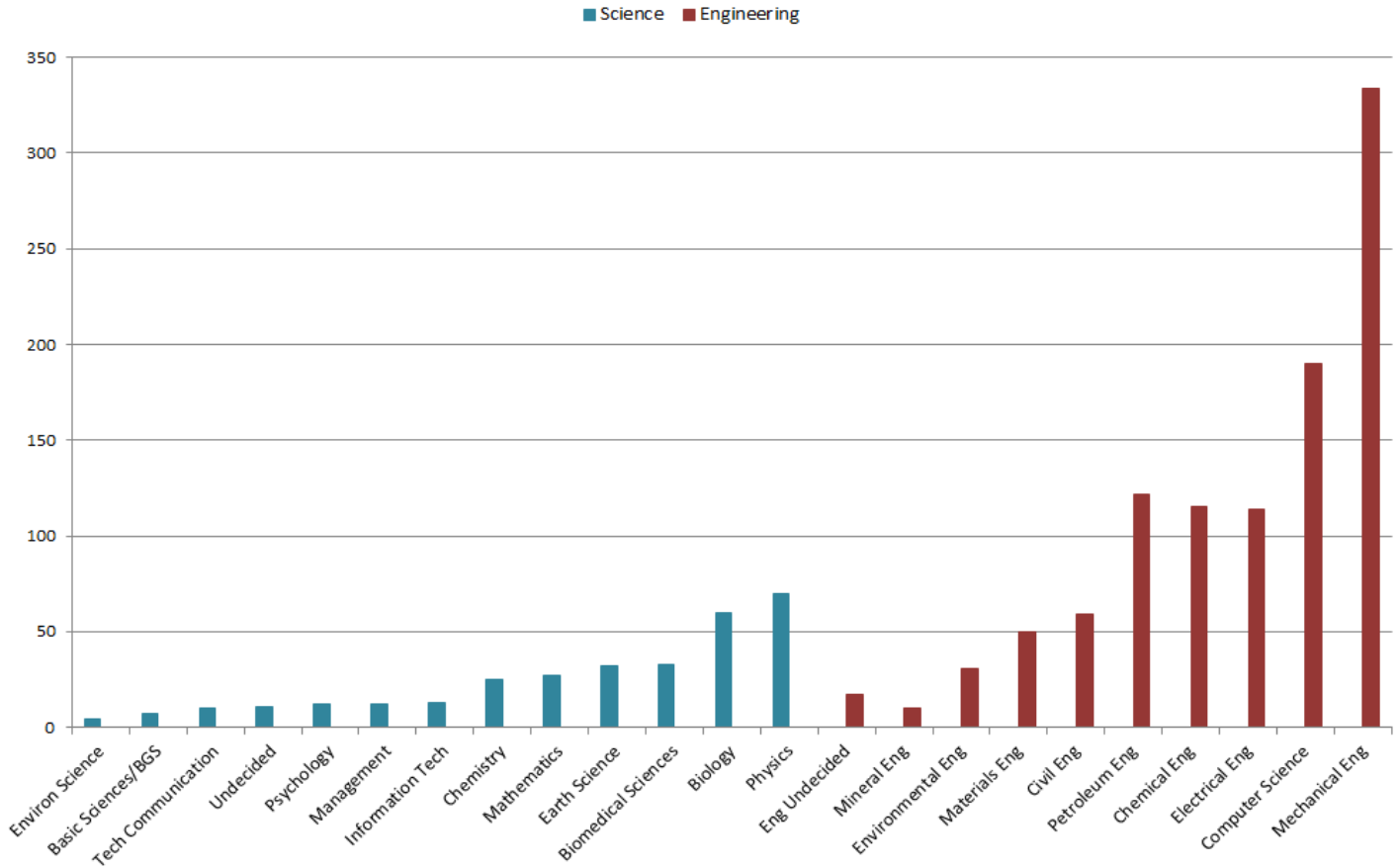

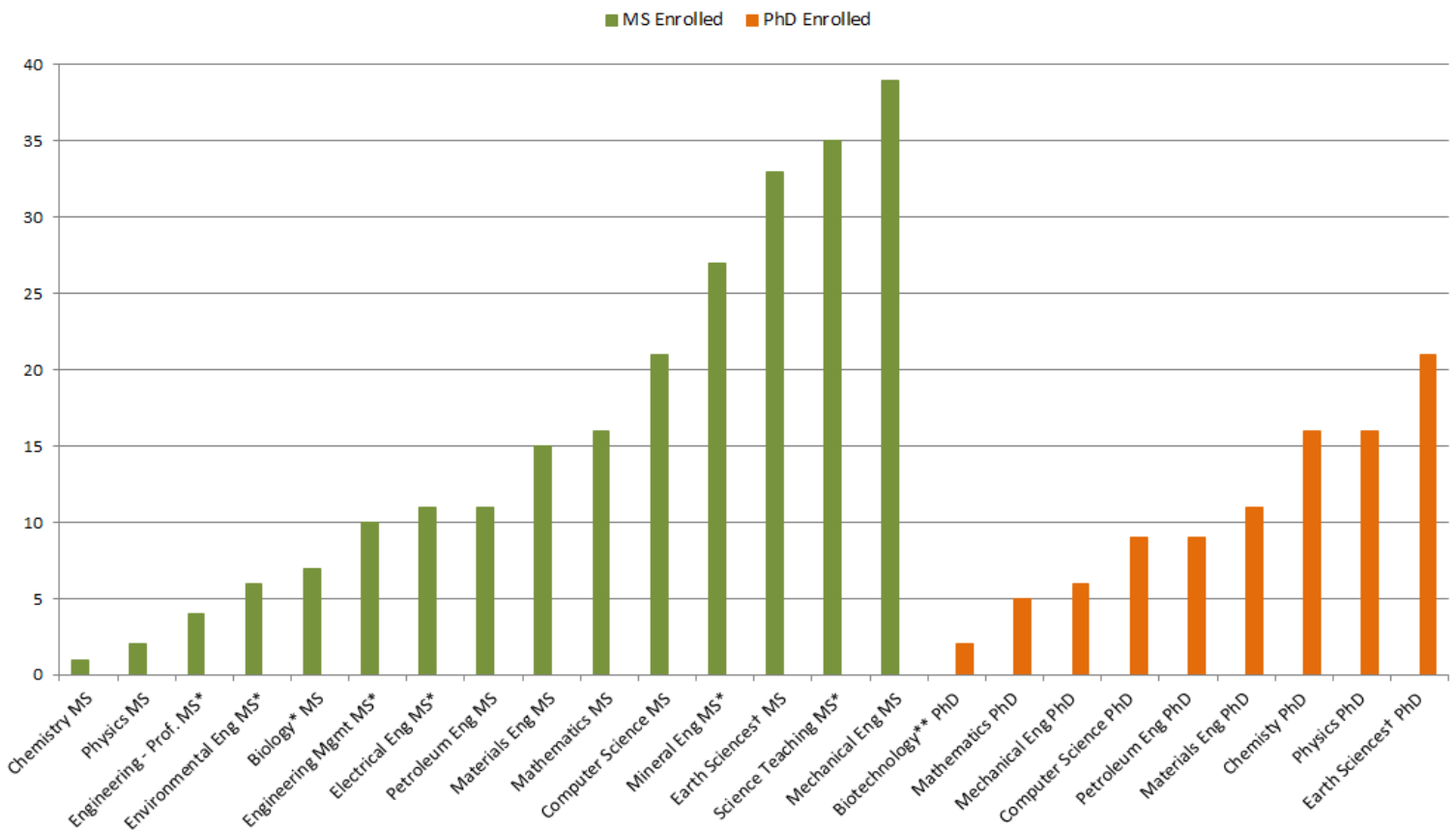

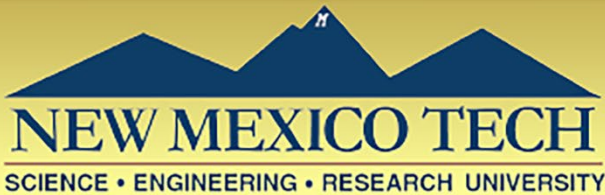
