
Application for Senate Bill Proposal

The American Society of Civil Engineers at New Mexico Tech is planning an overnight camping trip to Logan, New Mexico. We be taking this trip for the purpose of touring a bridge which will be undergoing construction by the New Mexico Department of Transportation and is therefore an excellent opportunity for our club members to see civil engineering at work in the real world. This trip will take place from 8am on Friday, September 27th, and last until Saturday, September 28th. We will need supplies for camping such as bug-spray, hand sanitizer, water bottles for drinking, charcoals to cook with, fire logs, and sunscreen for both the campsite and for the tour of the bridge. We will also need to make our food at the campsite, as the NMDOT will not be providing any food for us. We plan to use a school van as transportation and will be housed in tents at the campsite for the night.

For all of the aforementioned costs, the ASCE Club requests \$625 for our trip to Logan, New Mexico.
