Optical Interconnects Conference

Dear Senate Members,

I would like for you to consider helping the New Mexico Tech IEEE Chapter send members to the Optical Interconnects Conference in Santa Fe. This conference takes place on April 24th-26th. We intend to leave Wednesday Night to drive to Santa Fe, stay in an Airbnb on the Wednesday night and Thursday night and leave the Friday after the conference.

Currently the officers of the club plan on using some of the money in the IEEE account carried forward from the previous year to help fund the travel. In addition, we expect to get funding from the regional chapter of \$500 to help cover the cost. Therefore, the amount requested is \$608 which is the price for 2 registration fees and the difference in Airbnb price. This amount will allow us to take two more students to the conference since the travel cost will not change and the cost for lodging will only be \$48 more. Deciding by the date of 4/15/19 will allow us to reserve the Airbnb sooner.

This conference will really benefit the students who attend. New Mexico Tech offers an Optics minor and many students who plan on attending this conference are pursuing the Optics minor. The conference will allow students to learn more about current research being done and opportunities for graduate school.

Budget

Breakdown:

Registration: \$275 for each person if they are a member of the society for Optical Engineers. It is only \$5 to join the IEEE Photonics Society so we included that in the cost of registration.

Lodging: The cheapest option we have found for overnight stay is an Airbnb. The best price is called "Santa Fe Oven Ready's" which is \$86/night for four people, but including the miscellaneous fees amounts to \$234 for the two nights we plan on staying.

Travel: We plan on taking a Tech Vehicle at the rate of \$0.60/mile so we will not need to split into two cars. We already have members who have completed the defensive driving course so we will not need to pay the additional money for the course.
