## Senate Bill: NMT InterVarsity Chapter Camp Expense Request

NMT InterVarsity is requesting funds to cover the travel for our Spring Break retreat to Catalina Island off the coast of Los Angeles, with all of the emphasis on the cost of gasoline. The retreat itself is of major importance to InterVarsity as a national community of college students with Christian beliefs, as it allows for the members to go to a space away from the common distractions of life, bond with other InterVarsity members from across the nation, and spend time focusing on building a strong and healthy religious relationship. The members who have gone in the past still discuss it to this day as one of the most impactful and important weeks of their lives.

To summarize the Cost Estimate Official Breakdown, the total cost for the entire trip is \$19,000. This includes the price of registration, and the estimated prices of gas, lodging, and meals. Our estimates for prices were calculated with the following assumptions: 35 students, which is four more than last year's conference (we always try to bring as many people as possible), the prices on AAA's website gave us the average price of midgrade gasoline in New Mexico and Long Beach which allowed us to formulate an average cost of fuel for the trip, and that the average meal would cost \$9 with a total of seven meals being needed for the duration of the trip. To help cut down on the total price, we are communicating with a church in Pheonix to hopefully stay the night, similarly to last year. Also, we have fundraised \$1,500 to help students pay the cost of registration as they need it.

The total of \$19,000 is a lot to ask for, so our official request is \$3,500, which will cover the cost of fuel for the entire trip, especially if more students than expected register.
